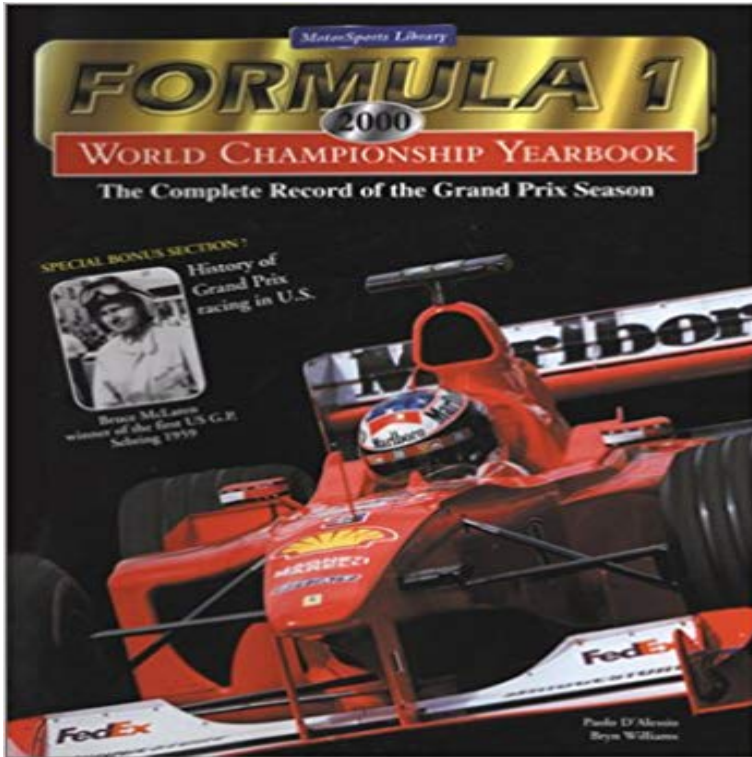


Formula 1 2001 World Championship Yearbook: The Complete Record of the Grand Prix Season
