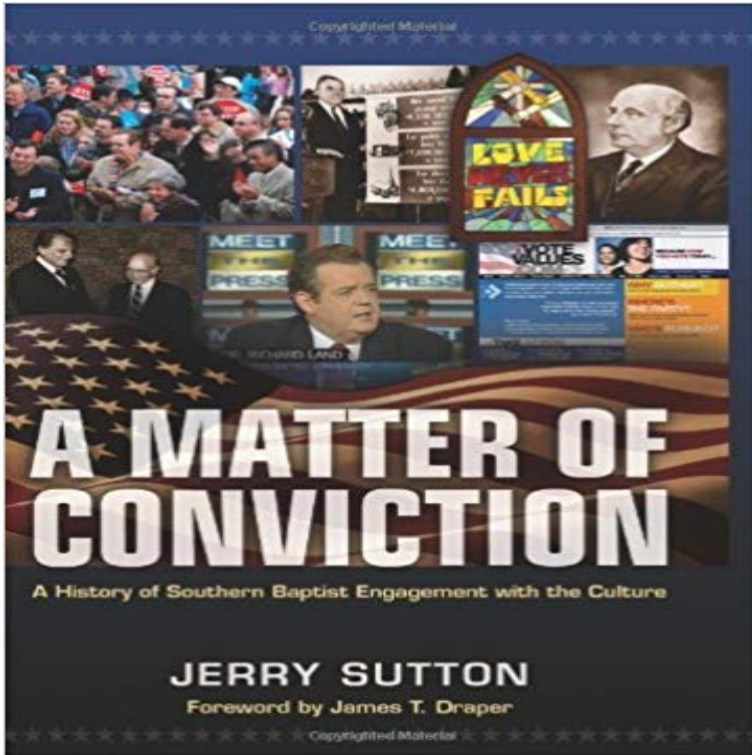


A Matter of Conviction: A History of Southern Baptist Engagement with the Culture
