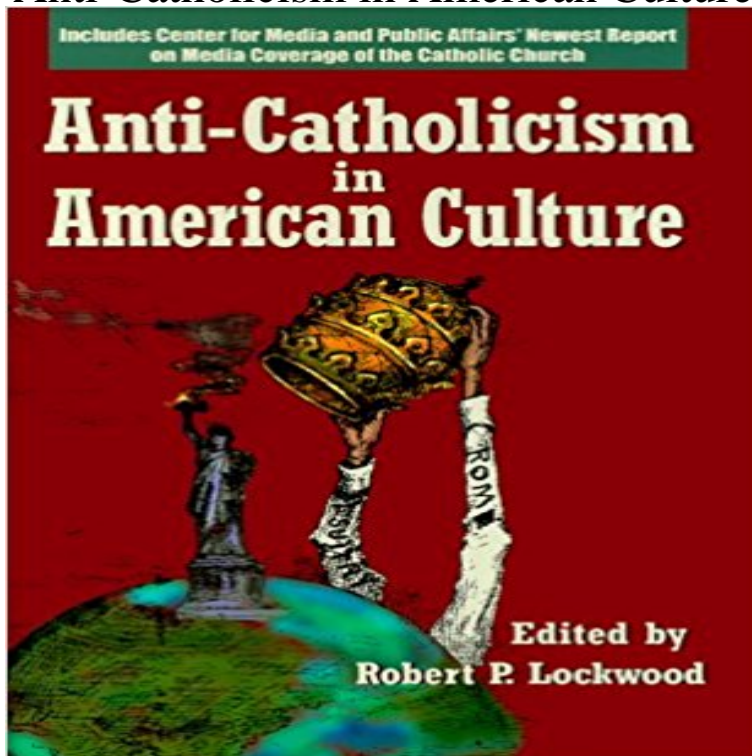


Anti-Catholicism in American Culture
