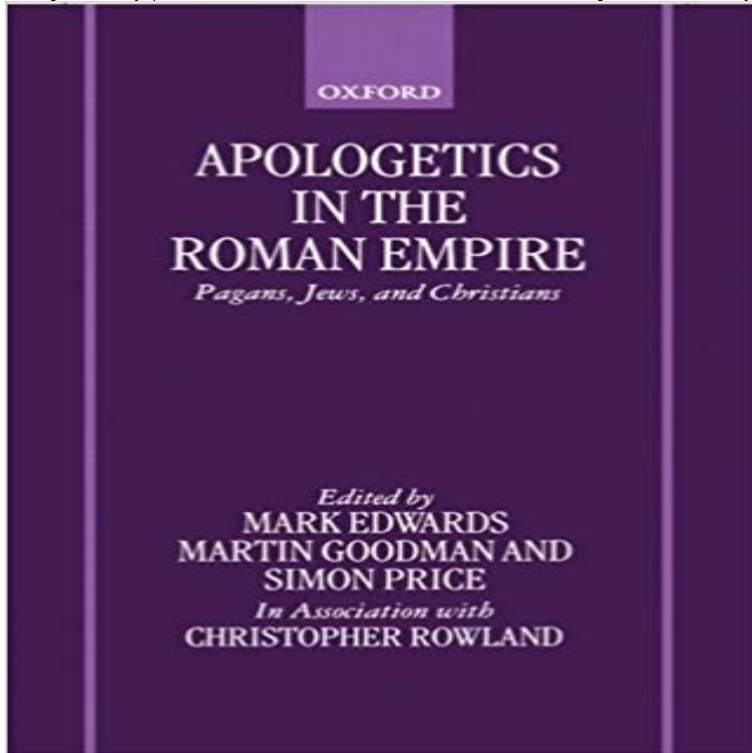


Apologetics in the Roman Empire: Pagans, Jews, and Christians
