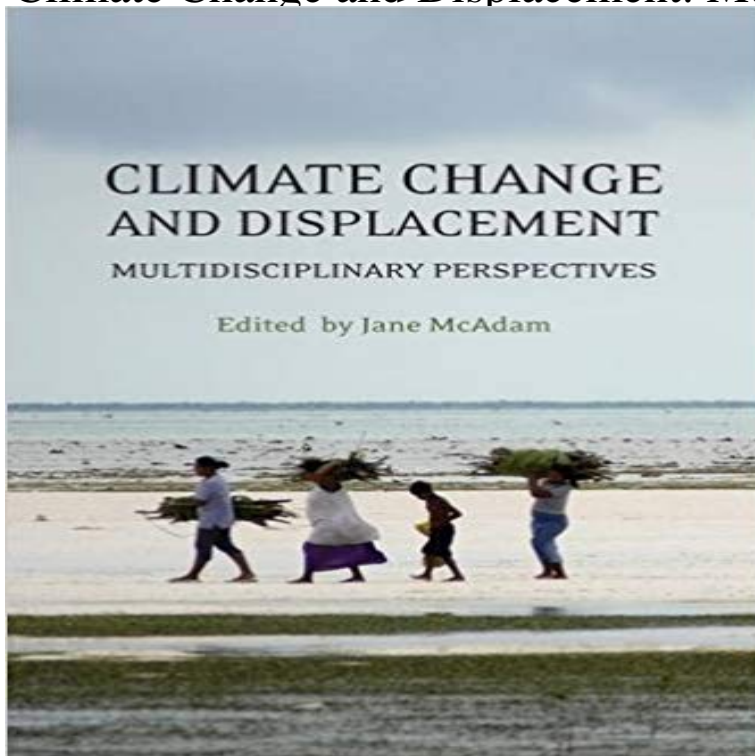


Climate Change and Displacement: Multidisciplinary Perspectives
