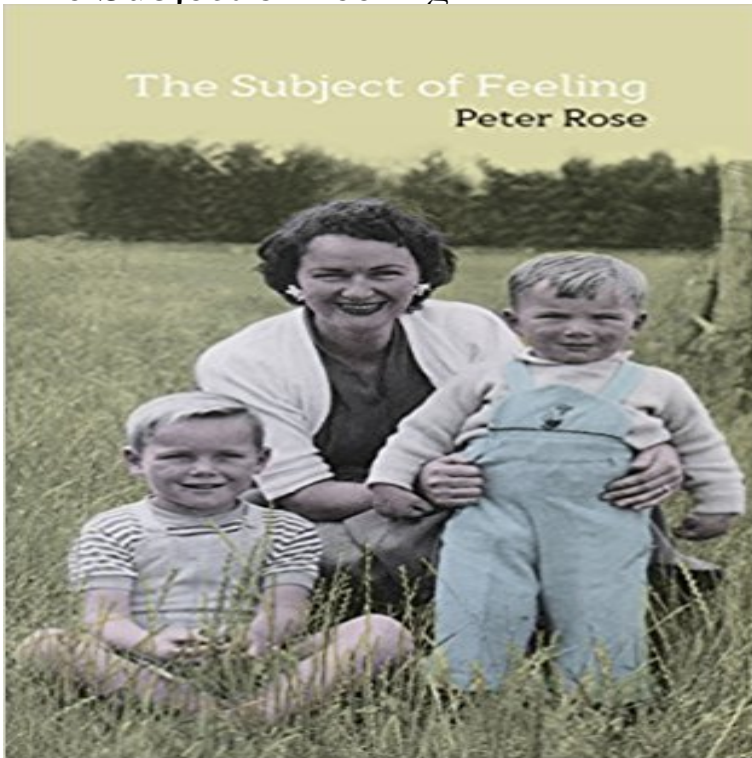


The Subject of Feeling
