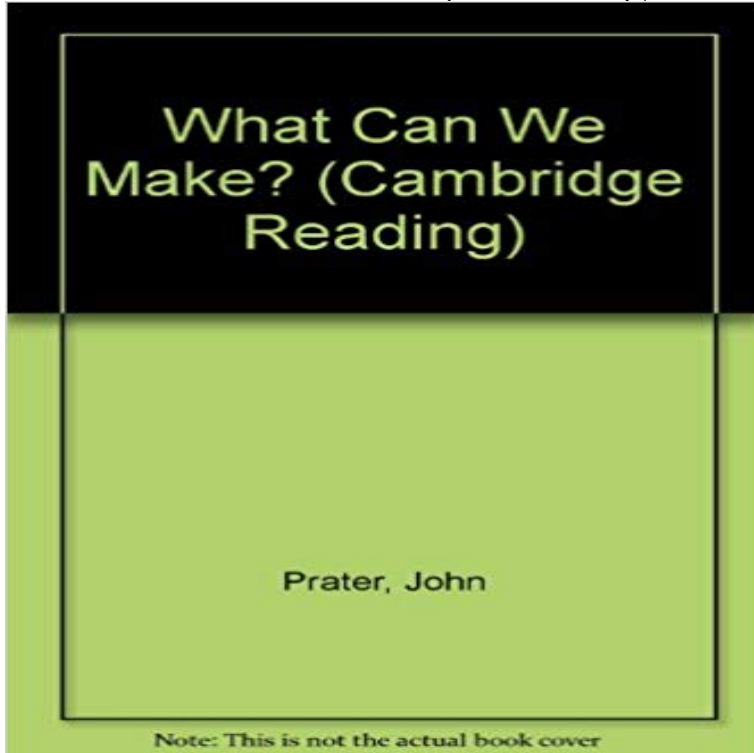


What Can We Make? (Cambridge Reading)
