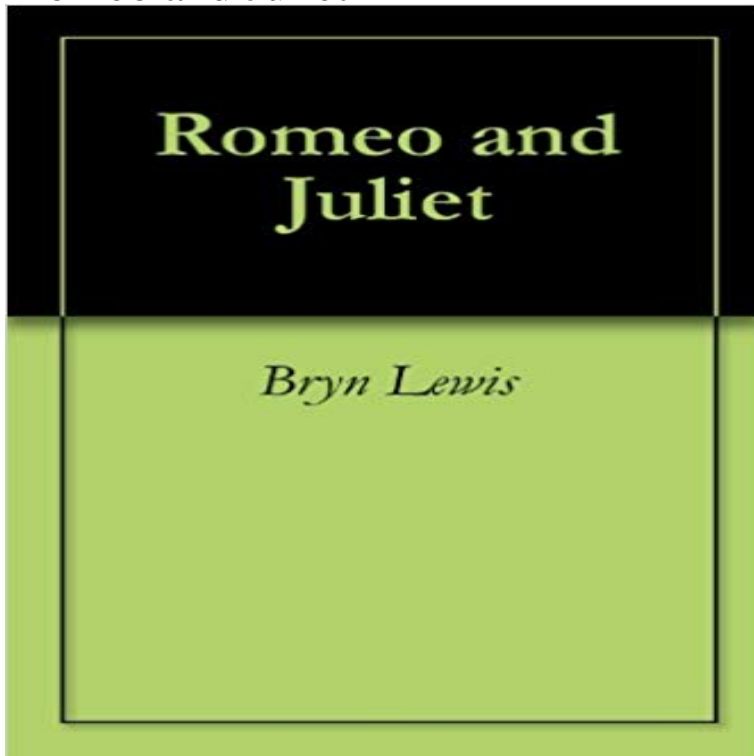


## Romeo and Juliet
