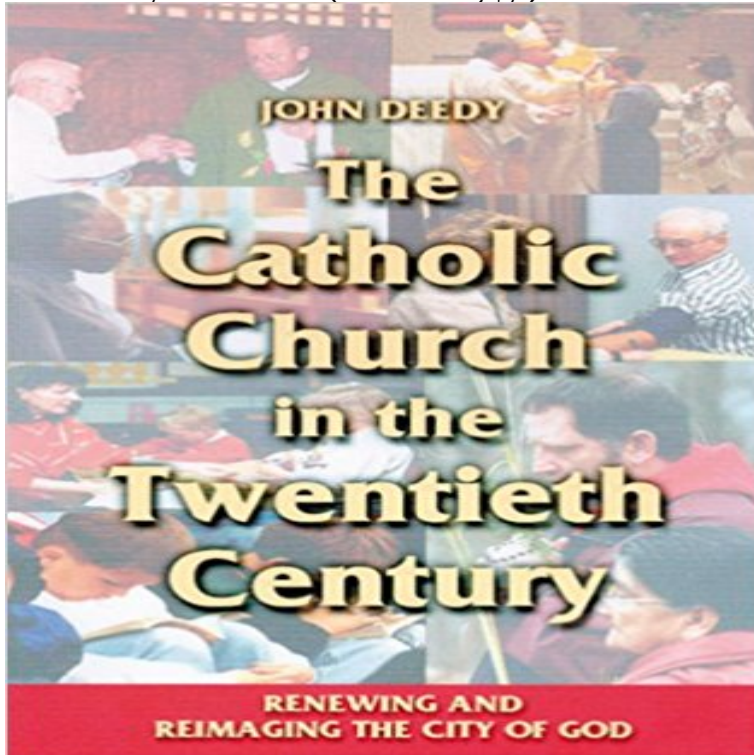


The Catholic Church in the Twentieth Century: Renewing and Reimagining the City of God (Theology)
