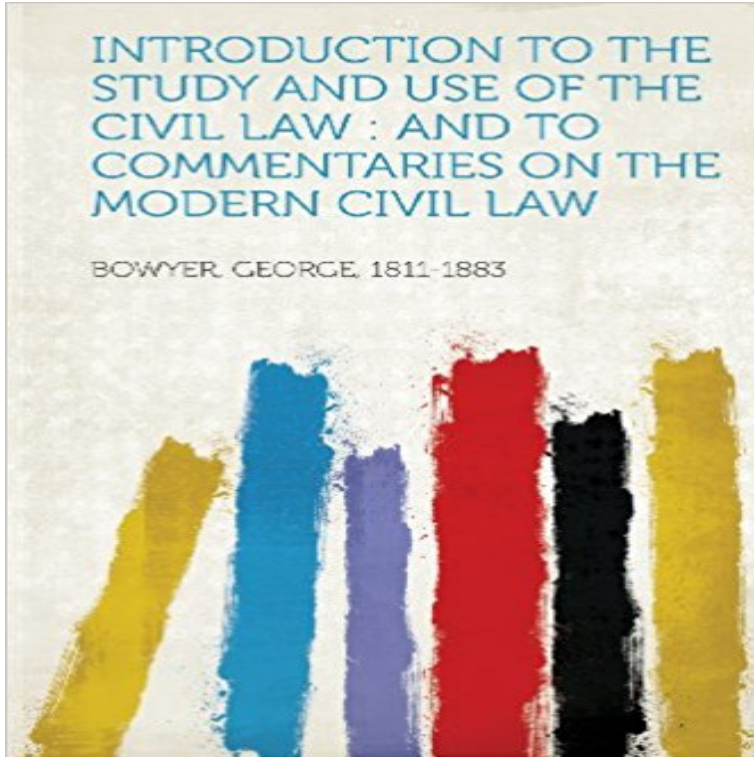


Introduction to the Study and Use of the Civil Law: and to Commentaries on the Modern Civil Law
