


Temptation: In the Desert (Daily Gospel Book 8)

Into the desert At once the Spirit drove him out into the desert, (Mk. 1:12) As soon as Jesus is baptized he is led into the desert by the Holy Spirit. This was one of the most significant events in the life of Jesus. Countless numbers of Christians have found strength and inspiration thru this event in the life of Jesus. The Holy Spirit drives Jesus away from the city and away from the commotion of Jerusalem into a deserted place where he is alone with God and the tempter. The spiritual life is comfortable when we are surrounded by the comforts and delicacies that the world has to offer. All good things that the world offers are sometimes just a distraction to the greatest good that God can provide and that is intimate communion in prayer and faith. These interior joys can only be experienced at the highest cost to oneself. Jesus will later tell his disciples that those who want to follow him must take up their Cross. Now he is giving them an example in which anyone can follow, since he will leave them the Holy Spirit that will lead them to all truth.
