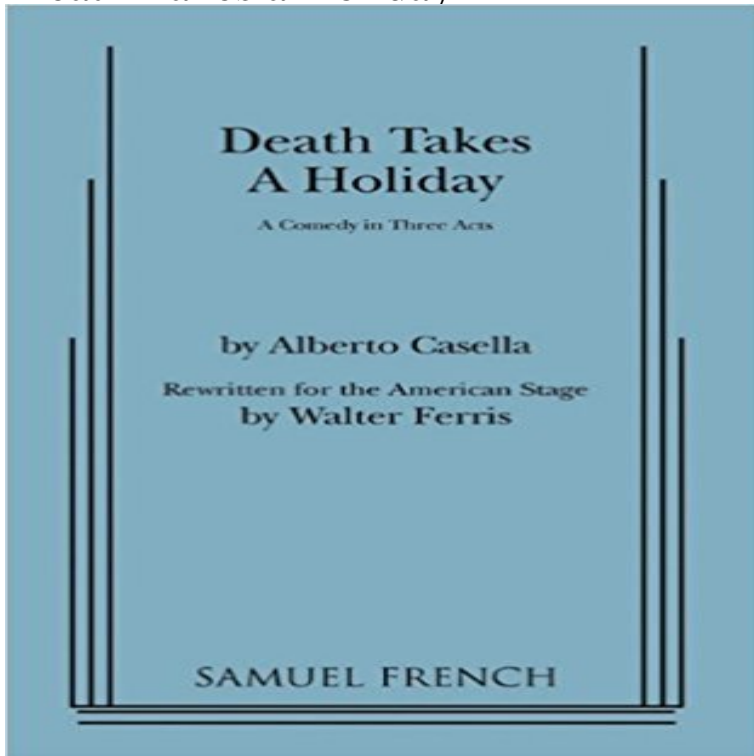


Death Takes a Holiday
