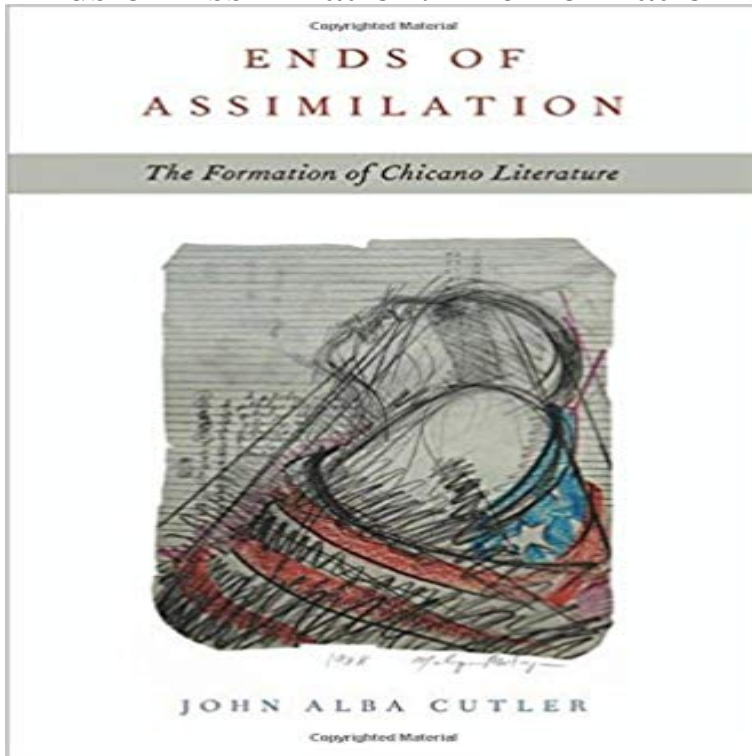


Ends of Assimilation: The Formation of Chicano Literature

With original analyses of works by canonical and noncanonical writers--from Americo Paredes, Sandra Cisneros, and Jimmy Santiago Baca to Estela Portillo Trambley, Alfredo Veá, and Patricia Santana--Ends of Assimilation demands that we reevaluate assimilation, literature, and the very language we use to talk about culture.
