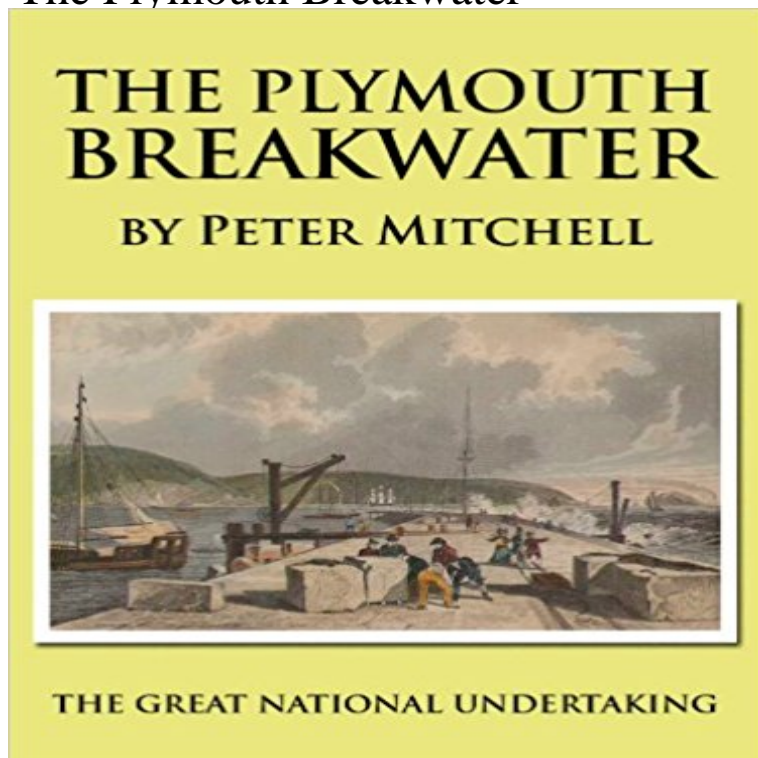


The Plymouth Breakwater
