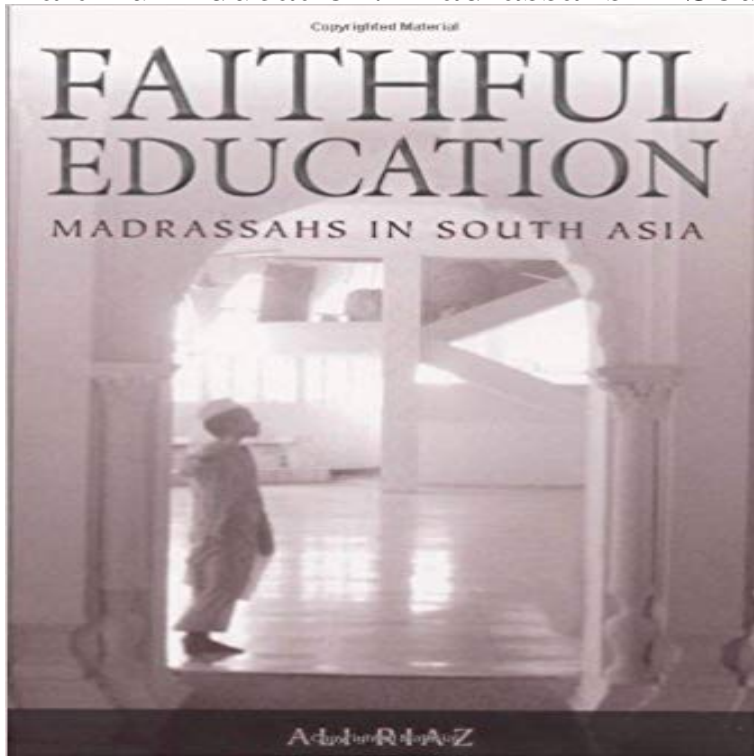


Faithful Education: Madrassahs in South Asia
