

Complete Narratives of Francophone Caribbean Tales (Caribbean Studies) (French Edition)



This anthology of Francophone Caribbean tales offers readings and replaces extracts with complete narratives. The selections provide a variety of stories from all the French-speaking regions of the Caribbean, including Guadeloupe, Guiana, Haiti, and Martinique, by both male and female authors. A short biographical sketch precedes each story, and there are also suggestions for classroom discussion. Other features include a general introduction placing the tales in their historical and cultural context, and explanations of unusual vocabulary.
