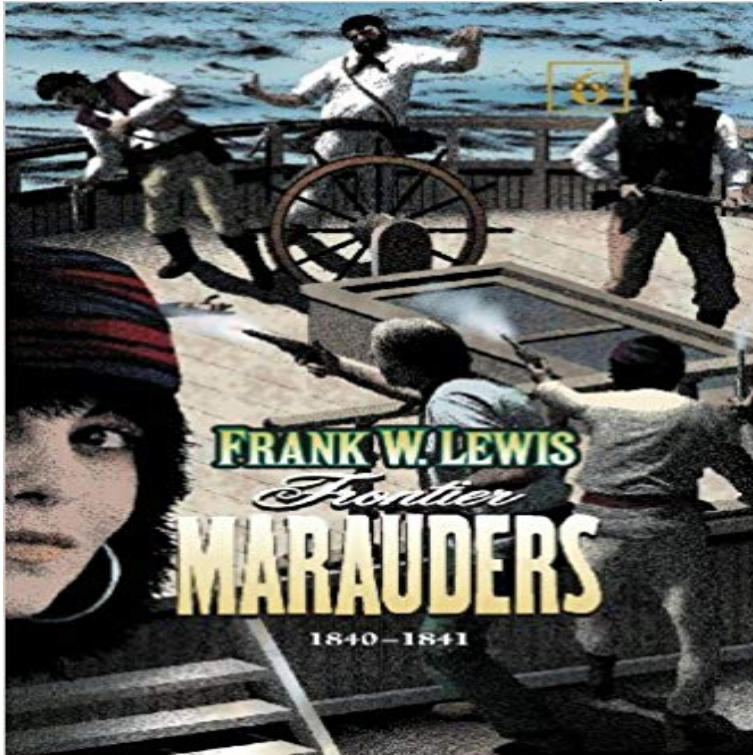


Frontier Marauders 1840 - 1841 (Volume 6)
