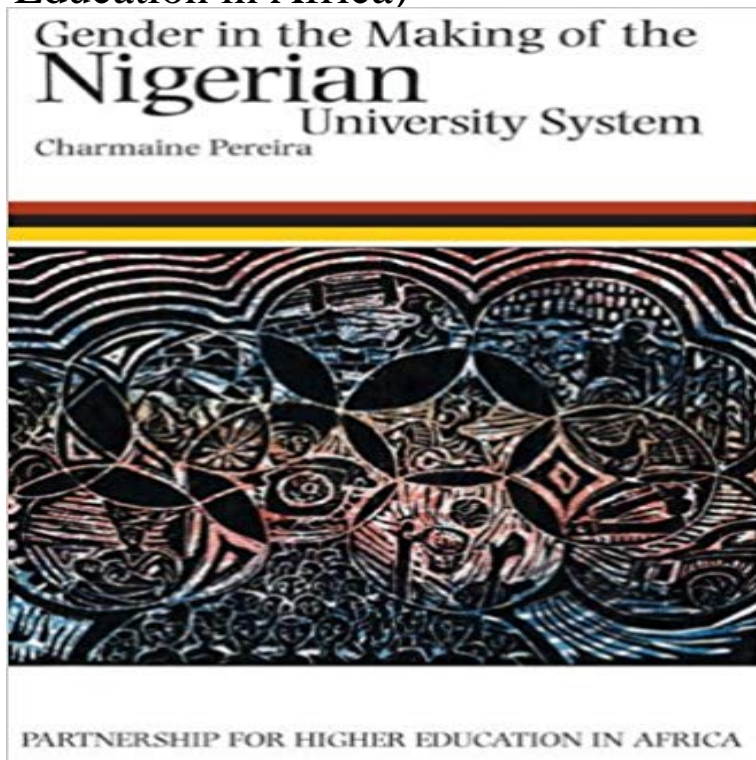


# Gender in the Making of the Nigerian University System (Higher Education in Africa)
