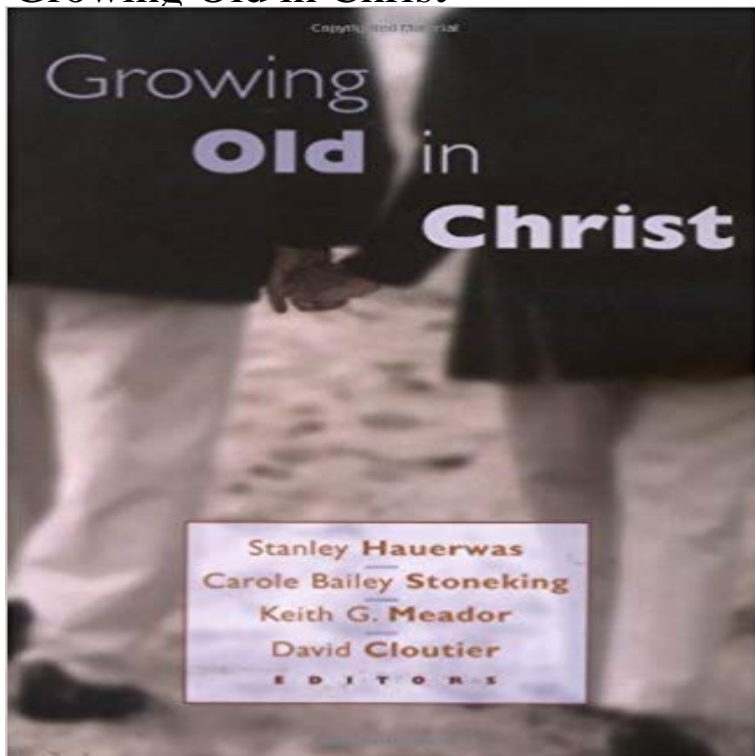


## Growing Old in Christ
