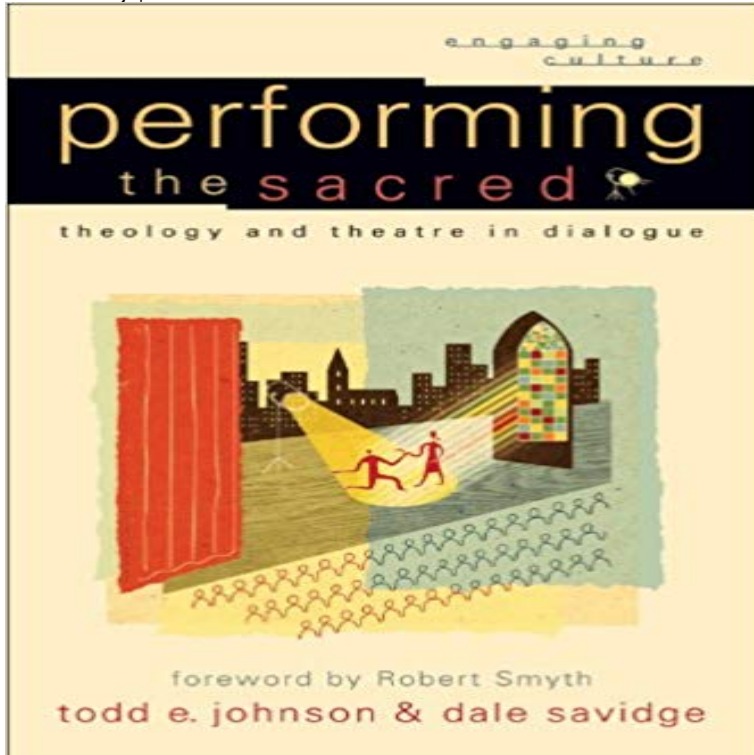


## Performing the Sacred (Engaging Culture): Theology and Theatre in Dialogue
