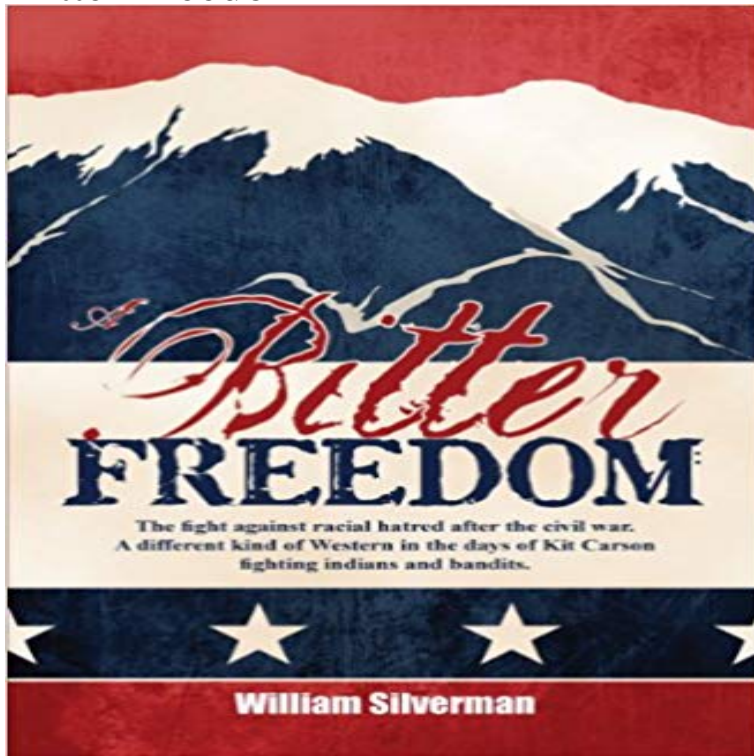


Bitter Freedom
