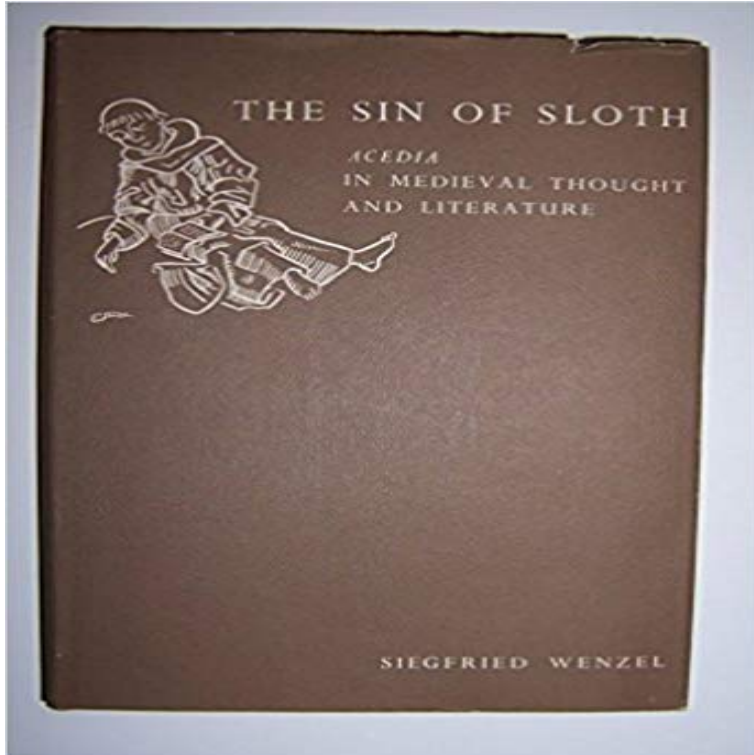


The Sin of Sloth: Acedia in Medieval Thought and Literature
