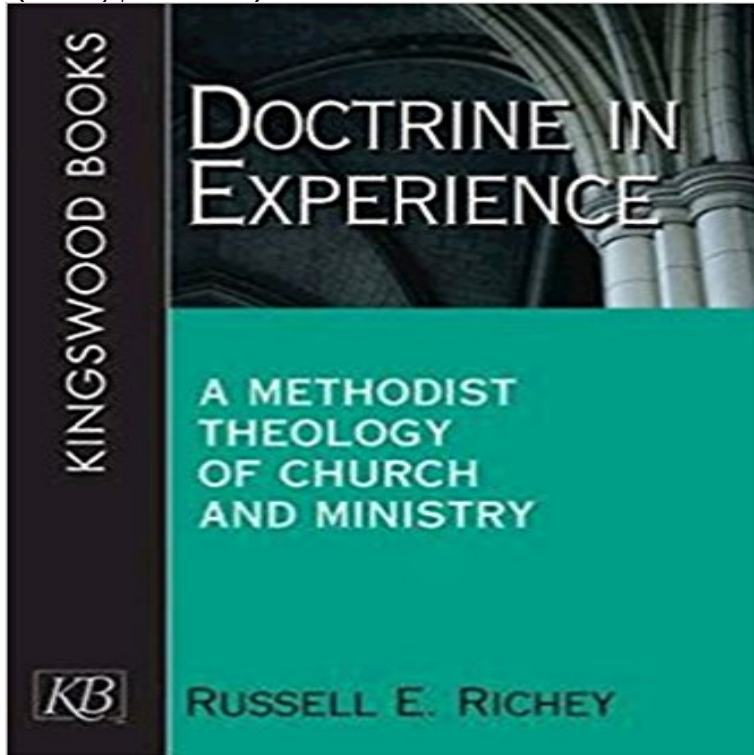


## Doctrine in Experience: A Methodist Theology of Church and Ministry (Kingswood)
