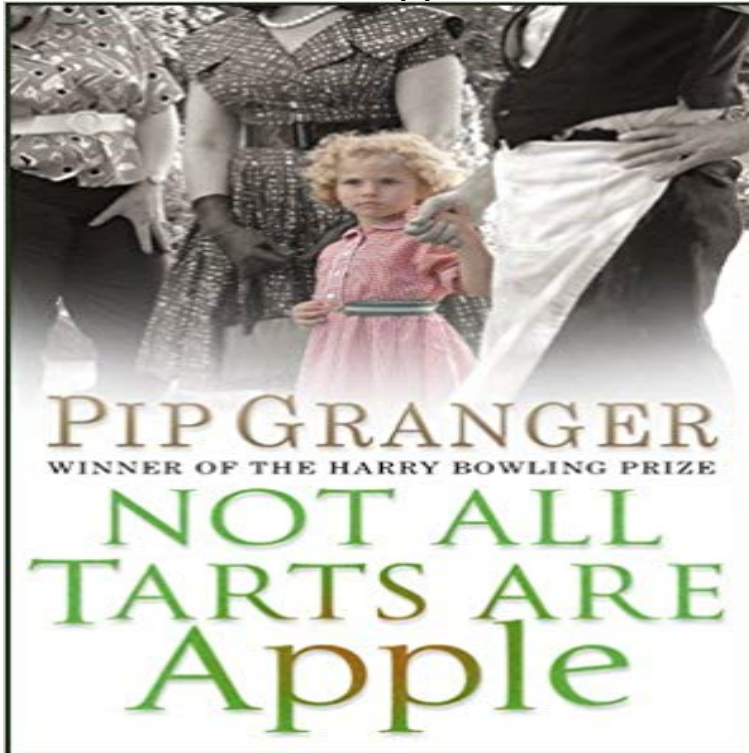


Not All Tarts Are Apple
