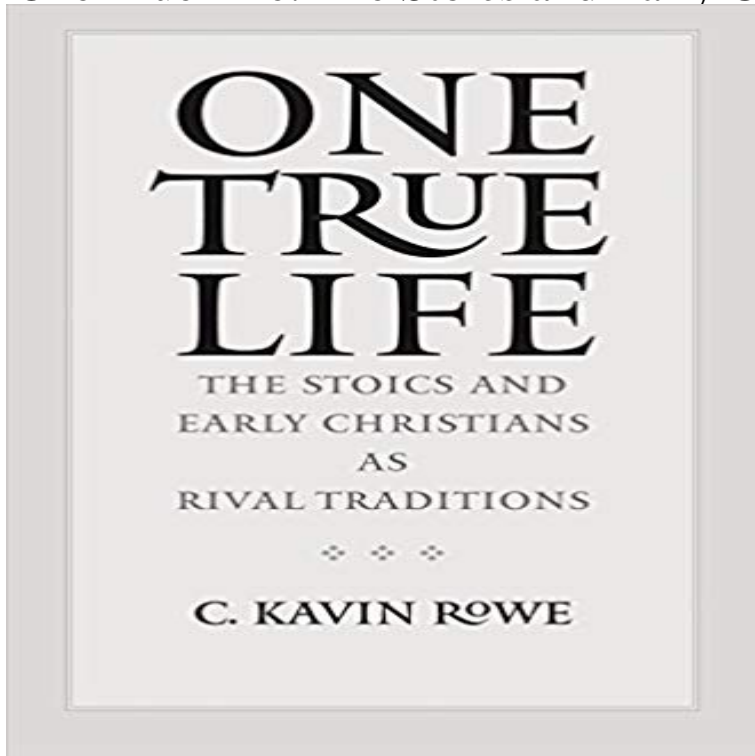


One True Life: The Stoics and Early Christians as Rival Traditions
