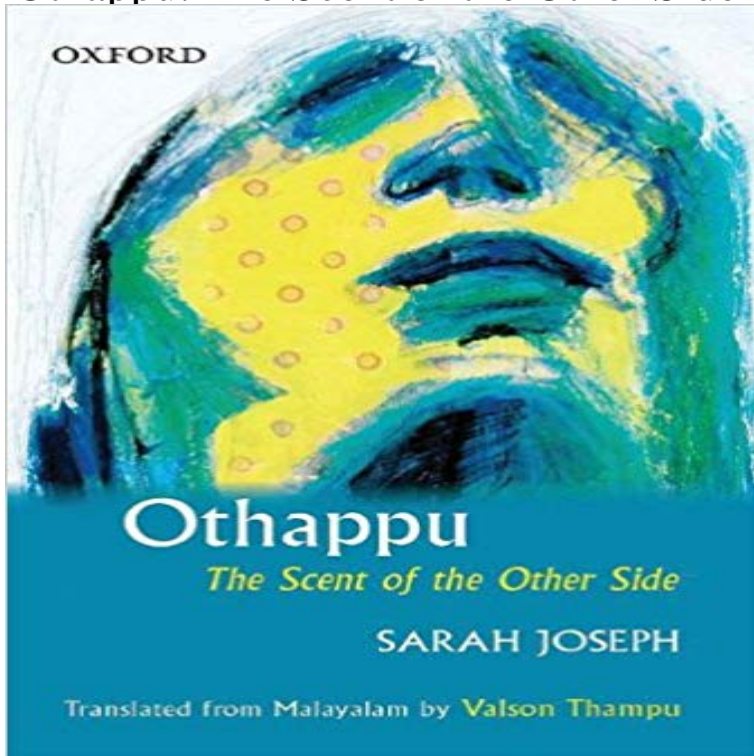


Othappu: The Scent of the Other Side
