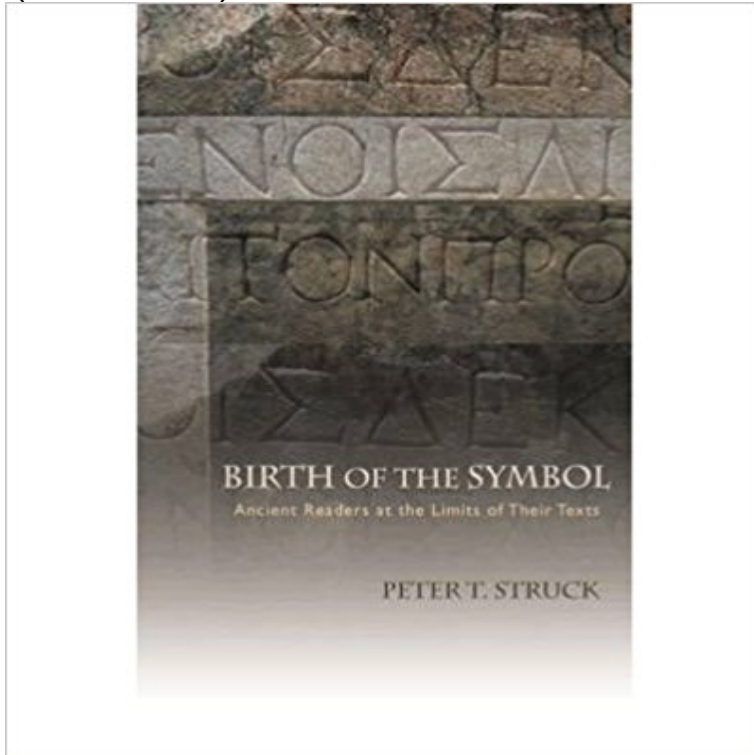


## Birth of the Symbol: Ancient Readers at the Limits of Their Texts (Hardback) - Common
