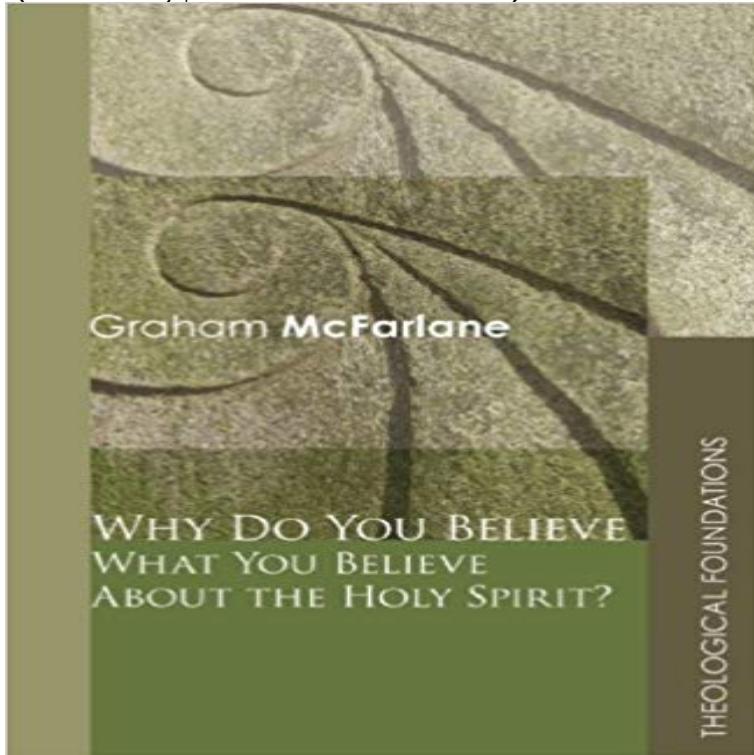


## Why Do You Believe What You Believe About the Holy Spirit?: (Theological Foundations)
