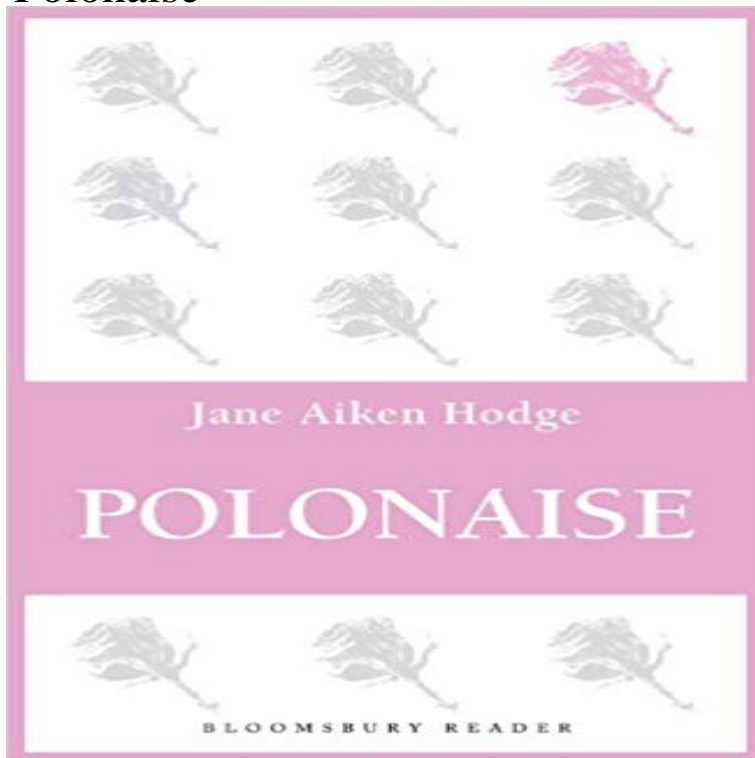


# Polonaise
