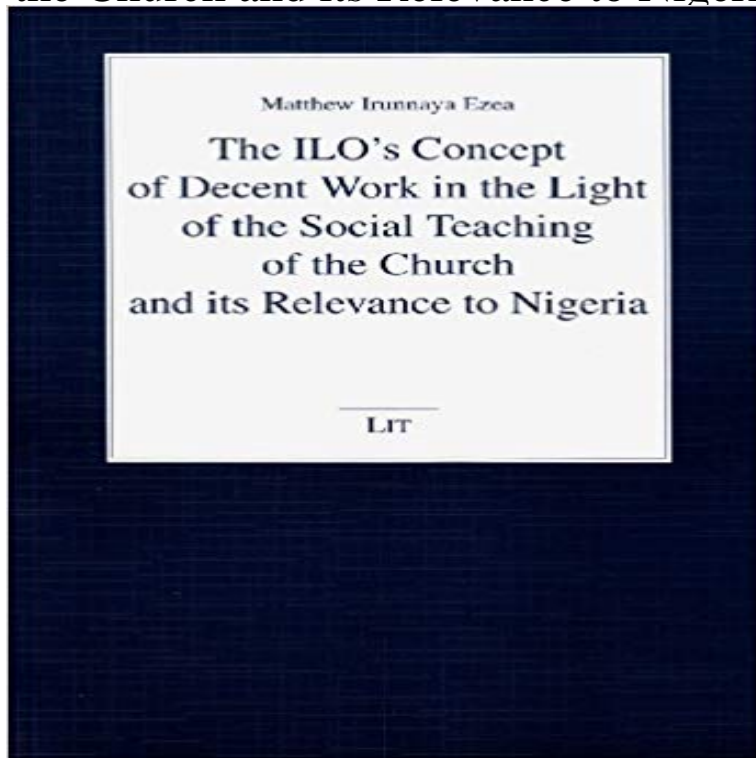


# The ILOs Concept of Decent Work in the Light of the Social Teaching of the Church and its Relevance to Nigeria (Theologie)
