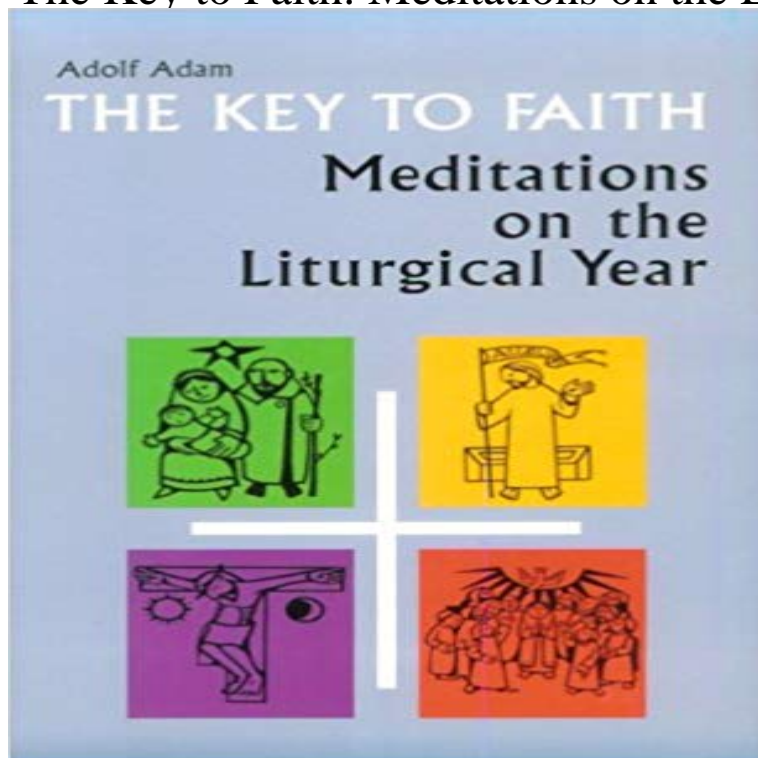


The Key to Faith: Meditations on the Liturgical Year
