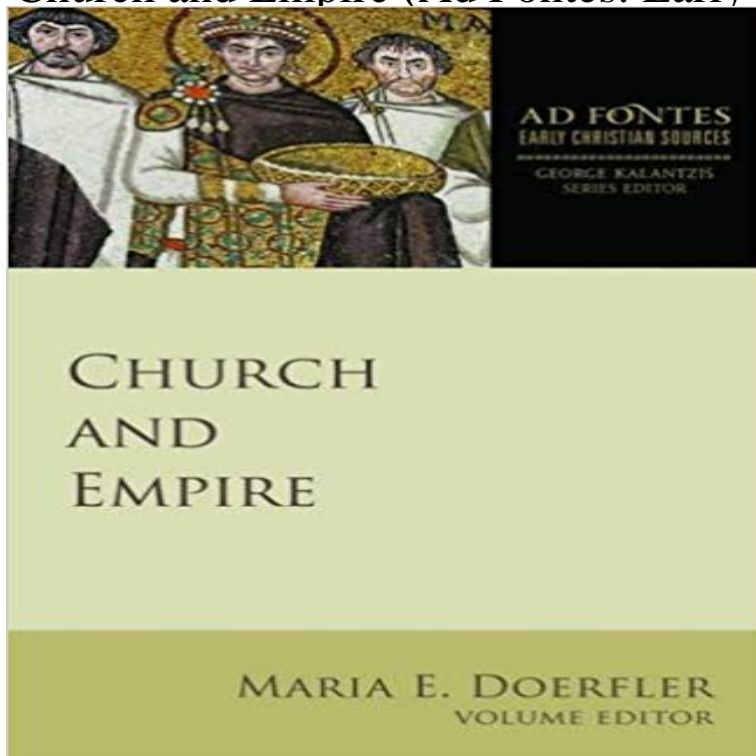


Church and Empire (Ad Fontes: Early Christian Sources)
