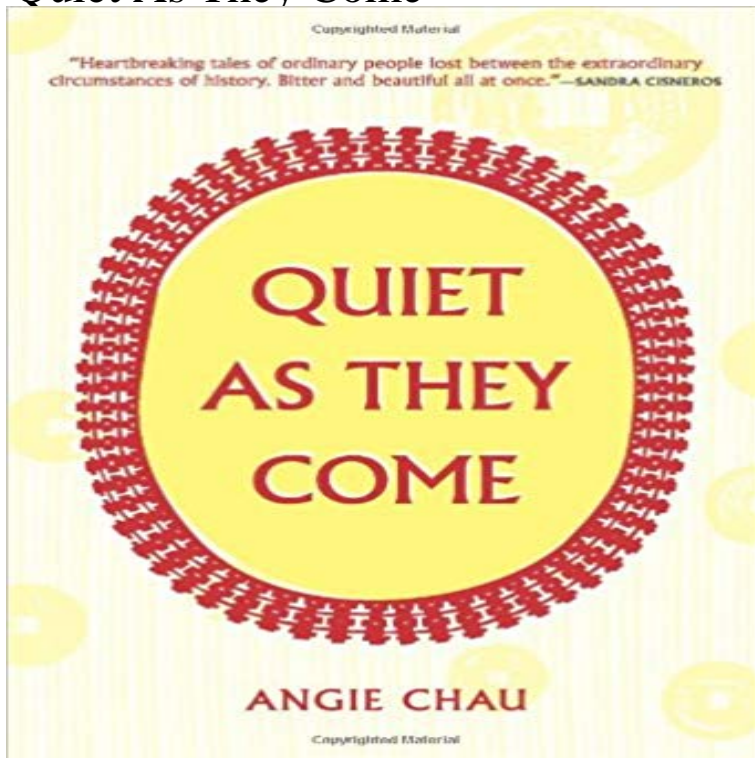


## Quiet As They Come
