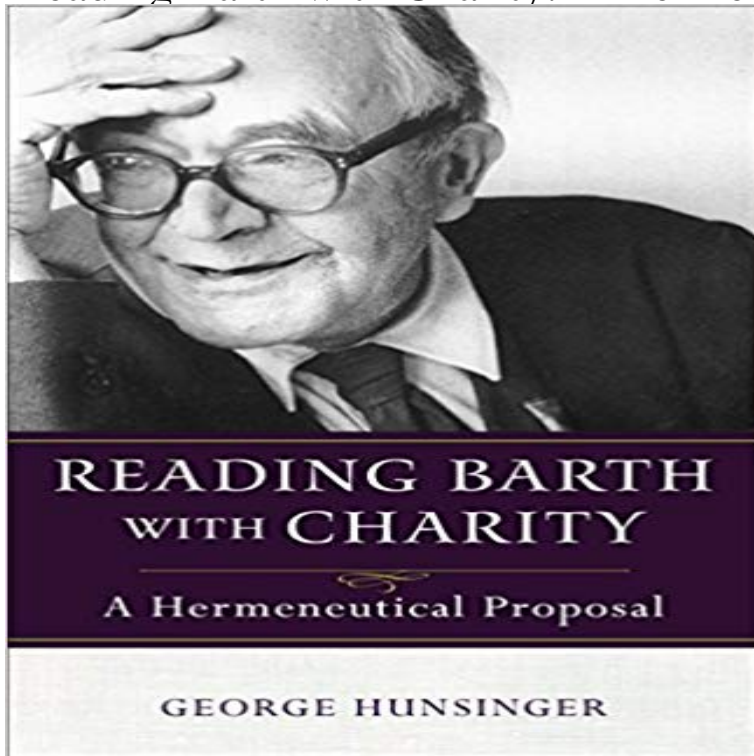


Reading Barth with Charity: A Hermeneutical Proposal
