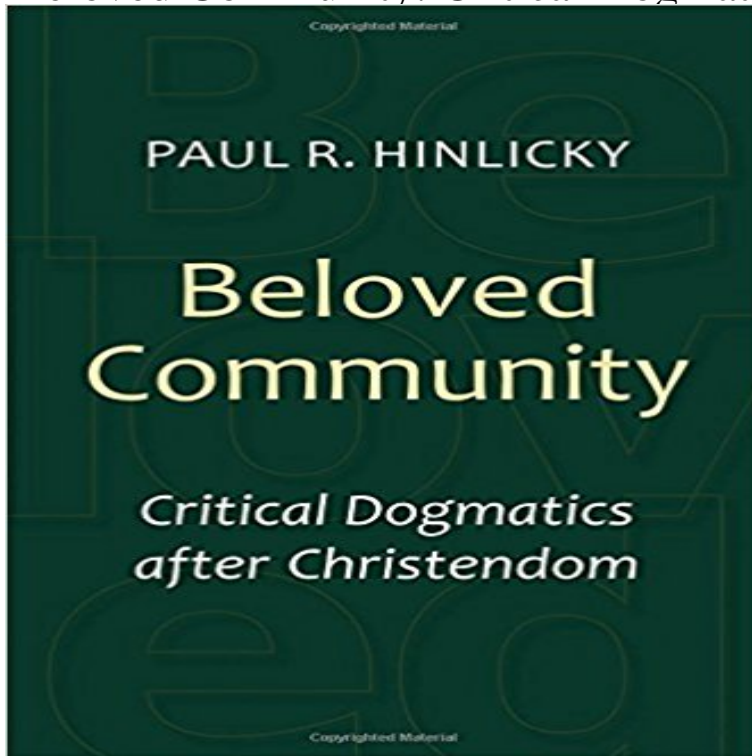


## Beloved Community: Critical Dogmatics after Christendom
