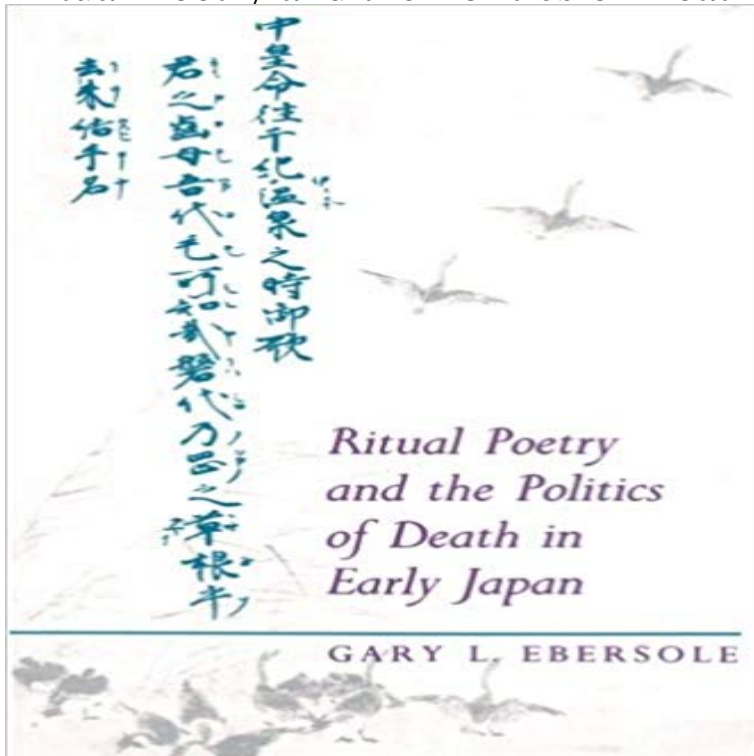


## Ritual Poetry and the Politics of Death in Early Japan
