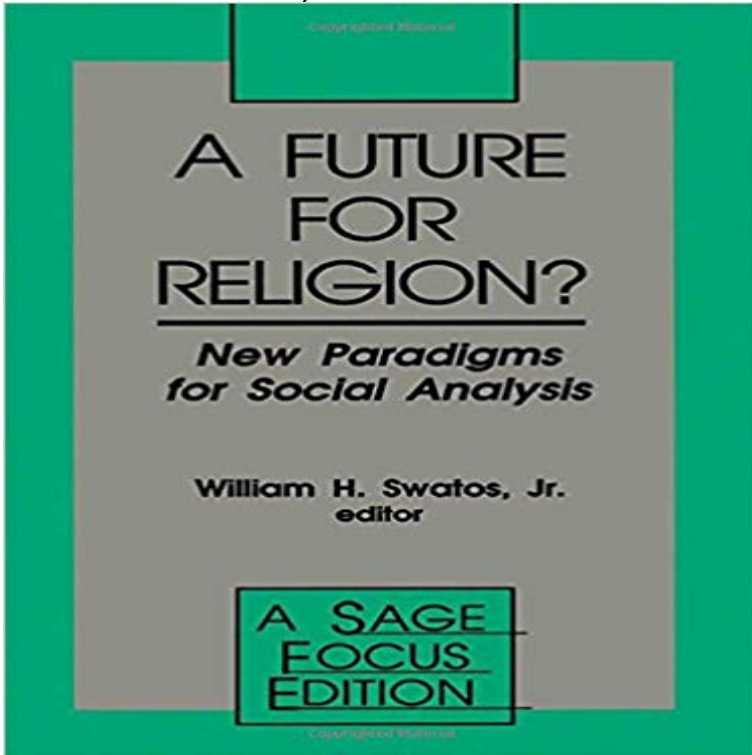


A Future for Religion?: New Paradigms for Social Analysis (SAGE Focus Editions)
