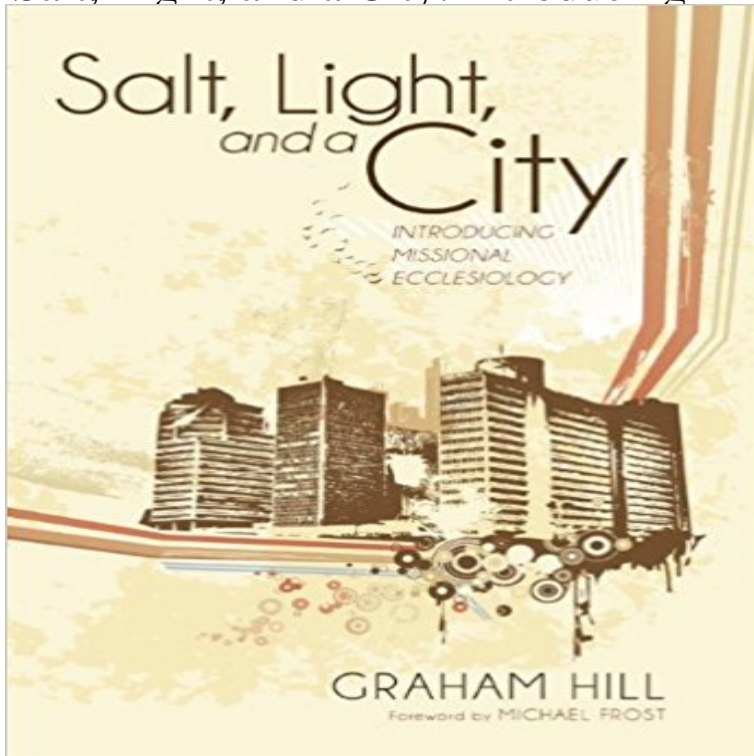


Salt, Light, and a City: Introducing Missional Ecclesiology
