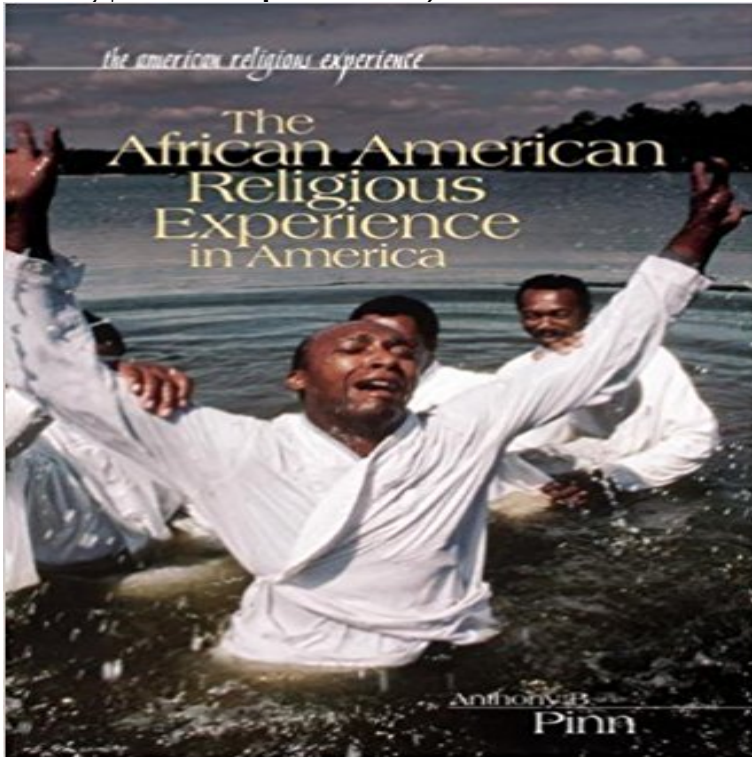


The African American Religious Experience in America (The American Religious Experience)
