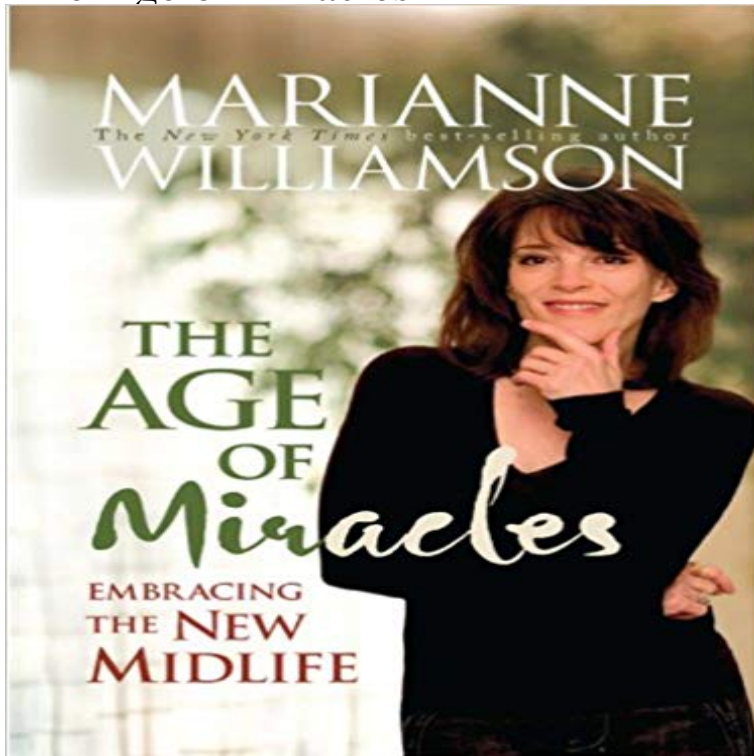


The Age of Miracles

And now at last, we have a destiny to fulfill not a destiny of a life that's simply over, but rather a destiny of a life that is finally truly lived. Midlife is not a crisis; it's a time of rebirth. It's not a time to accept your death; it's a time to accept your life and to finally, truly live it, as you and you alone know deep in your heart it was meant to be lived.
