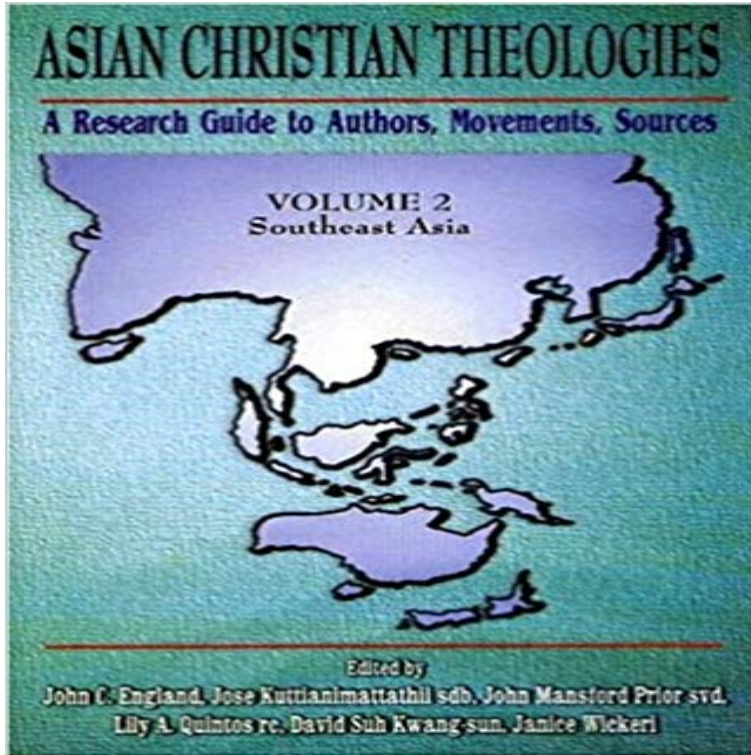


Asian Christian Theologies: A Research Guide to Authors, Movements, Sources: Southeast Asia
