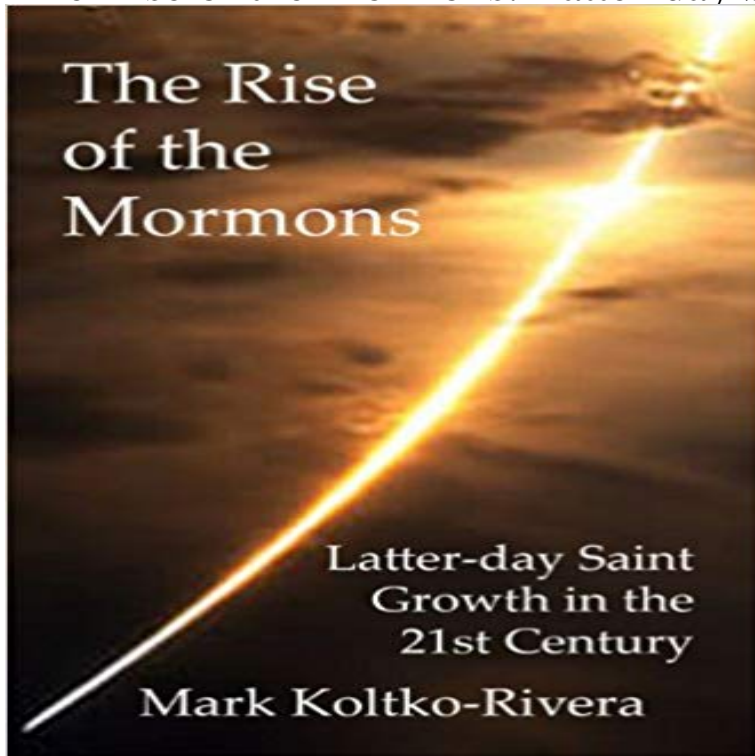


The Rise of the Mormons: Latter-day Saint Growth in the 21st Century
