


Till Shadows Have Eaten the Moon: Songs of Life and Love



Do you like lyric poetry with real rhyme and meter? This book has over a hundred from a few old favorites to hard-to-find ones you have never seen, including 19 first published here all about love. Do you like poems of deep wisdom or powerful emotion? Some poems here will mist your eyes no matter how often you read them. Do you like books full of big, gorgeous pictures, mostly in color? This 300-page book has nearly 200, to illustrate whole or parts of poems, or to show an authors portrait made close to when he or she wrote the poem. Some poems are not suited to pictures, but most are. The song Till Shadows Have Eaten the Moon (which gave the book its title) has 28 color photos, spread over more than a dozen pages. (Reprint rights to just one of them cost more than the price of this whole book.)

Are you tired of textbook anthologies full of poems of uneven worth, arbitrarily grouped by topic, period when written, author, or title? Poems in this book are arranged so earlier ones help you understand later ones. There are no duds, just for the sake of inclusion. If you resist jumping around, the emotional impact builds steadily as you go. Also, the prose text before each poem will give you key facts about its author (not a dry biography), describe events surrounding its writing, and explain words used or pronounced in a way now uncommon. For instance, for Auld Lang Syne (lyrics by Robert Burns in 1788), the annotation contains a 22-entry Scottish-to-English glossary, so you will know what the song really means and why it is sung at milestone events. Do you like proverbs or pithy quotes? You will find both here, scattered among the annotations.

Do you ever suspect a poem is misquoted or wrongly attributed? To assure accuracy, every poems wording, punctuation, and authorship were researched thoroughly. Where questions remain, you are told. Are you annoyed by typos, even in

expensive books from major publishers? This book was scrupulously examined by a highly experienced professional proofreader who spent an entire week checking every aspect of the text. Also, the book author hand typeset all poems for best appearance. Are you ready to own a high quality, profusely illustrated book of soulful lyric poetry, unlike any other? Then buy this book now. Its a keeper.
