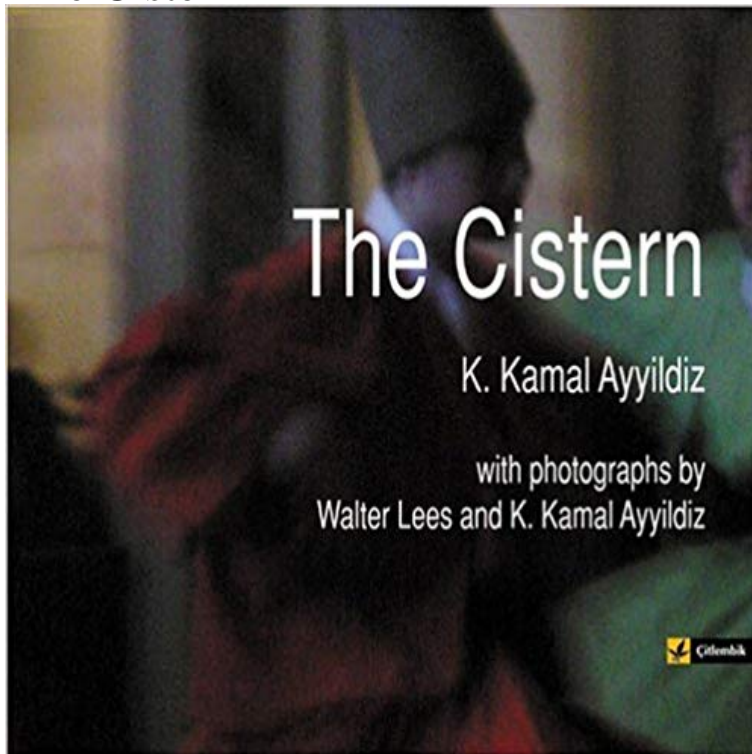


The Cistern
