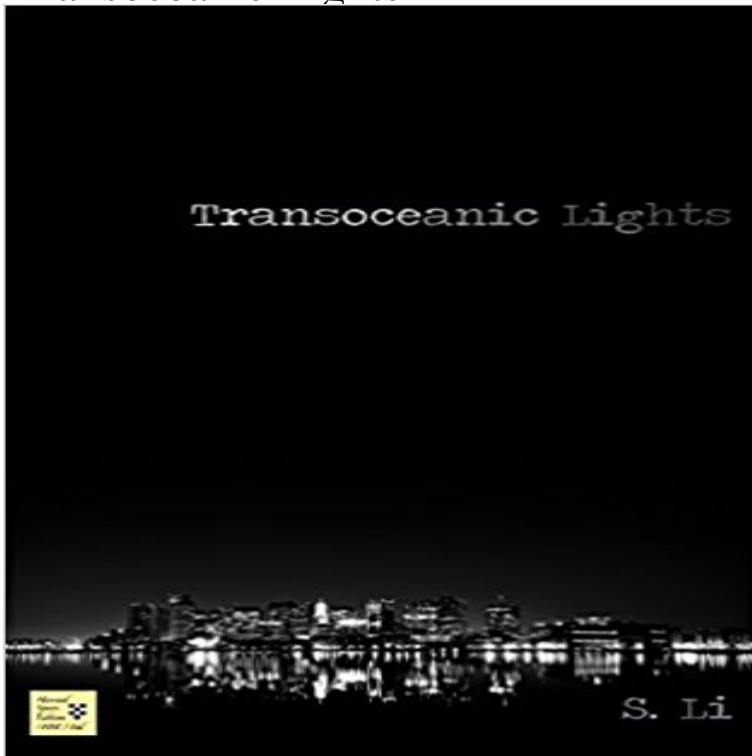


## Transoceanic Lights
