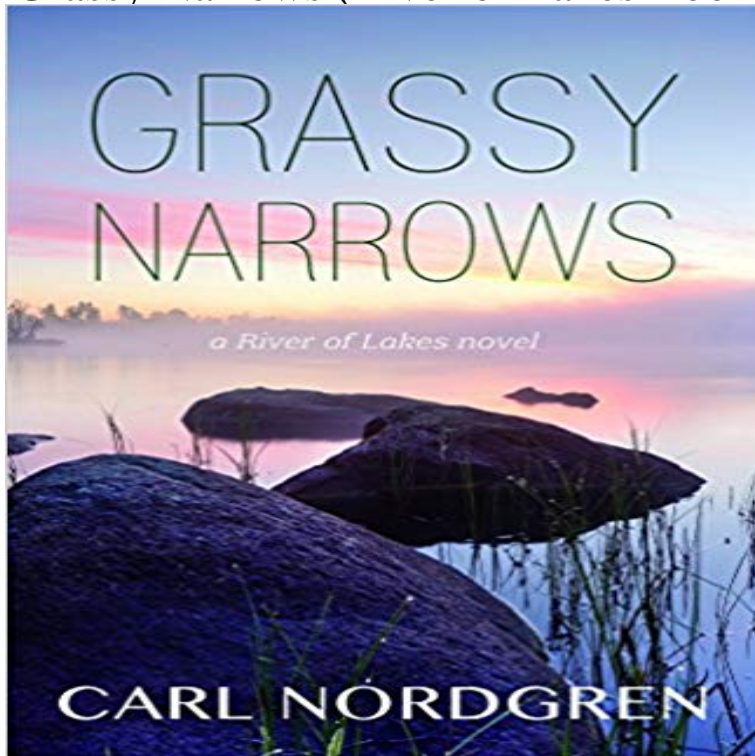


## Grassy Narrows (River of Lakes Book 3)
