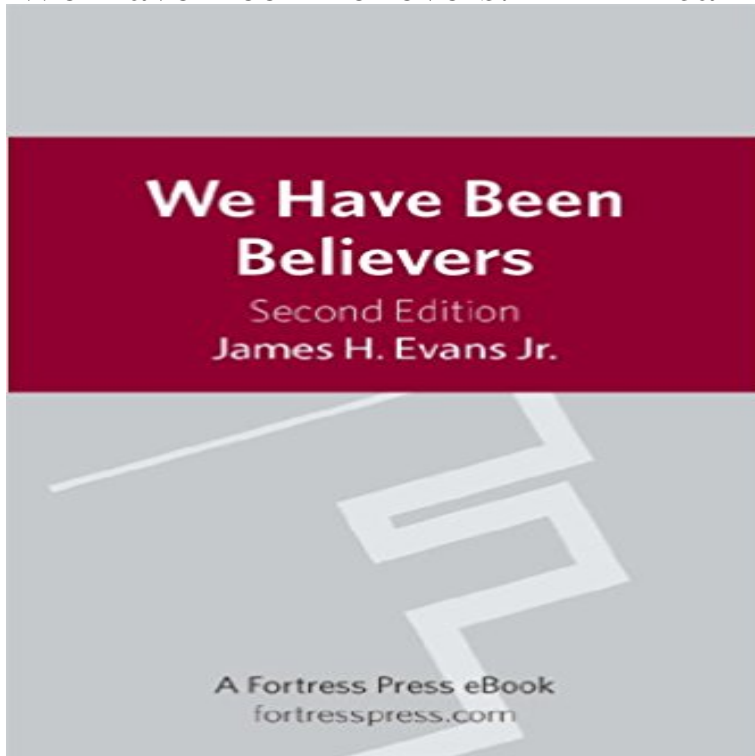


# We Have Been Believers: An African American Systematic Theology
