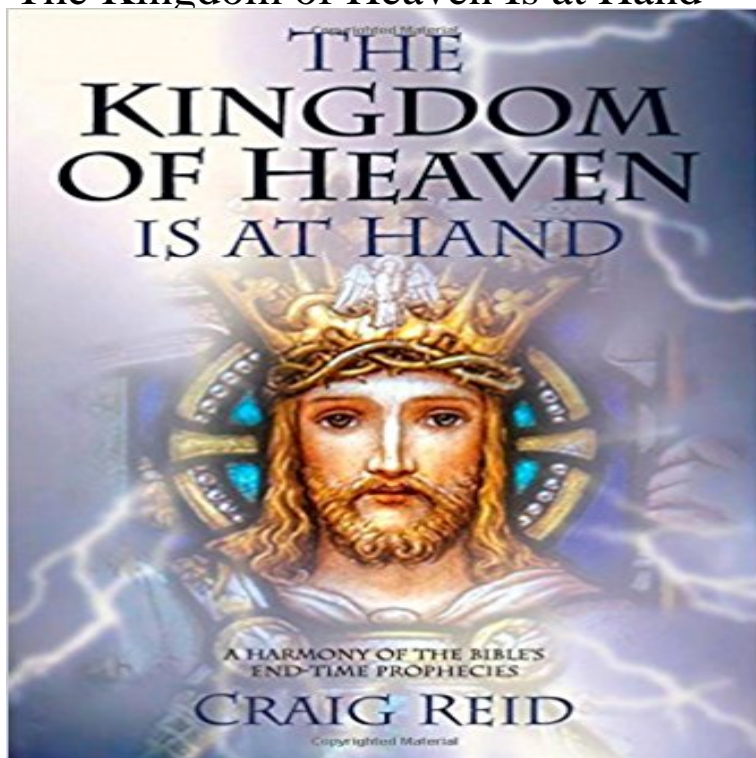


The Kingdom of Heaven Is at Hand
